

## -Checklist for Taltson Bay Big Pike Lodge

- Passport (Don't leave home without it!)

### Bedding

- 1 Northface sleeping bag with travel bag (40 degree, 86" length, 2.5 lbs)
- 1 Inflatable travel pillow or 1 pillowcase (fill with shirts or jacket)

### Clothing

- 4 Pairs of convertible pants
- 4 T-shirts
- 3 Long sleeve T's
- 2 Hooded sweatshirts
- 2 Hooded fleece pullovers
- 1 Set of long underwear
- 7 Pairs of underwear
- 7 Pairs of socks
- 1 Winter cap
- 2 Pairs of gloves
- 1 Extra pair of waterproof shoes
- 1 Set of FroggTroggs rain/wind gear
- 1 Seasonal jacket if needed (check forecast)
- 3 Baseball caps (different colors recommended for photos)

We suggest using vacuum bags to shrink clothes.

### Necessities

- 1 Digital camera
- 1 Memory card (2MG)
- 2 Sets of rechargeable batteries + charger for camera
- 1 Disposable digital camera
- 1 Tube of Crazy Glue (fixes lures and cuts)
- 1 Basic first aid kit in tackle bag
- 1 Toothbrush
- 1 Travel size toothpaste

- 1 Deodorant
- 1 Bar of soap
- 1 Travel size sun block
- 1 Travel size insect repellent
- 1 Towel
- 1 Wash cloth
- 1 Lighter (check travel restrictions)
- 1 iPod/MP3 player with collapsible travel speakers
- 2 Pairs of polarized glasses

Also, bring any necessary medication(s)

Optional extras to bring:

- Individual instant drink mixes
